PUBLIC INTEREST ENTITY STATUTORY REGISTRATION

FOR THE YEAR 2024

The Gambia Financial Reporting Oversight Board (FROB) emphasizes the obligation for all Public Interest Entities (PIEs) to register in accordance with sections 57(2 & 3) of the Financial Reporting (FR) Act, 2013. PIEs must register by March 31st, 2024, as failure to do so may result in penalties and legal consequences.

The FROB would like to draw to the attention of the public and the business community the newly set PIE thresholds pursuant to section 2 (e) of the FR Act 2013. REGISTRATION PROCESS:

We encourage our stakeholders to use the resources available on our website to assist them in meeting their statutory obligations as a Public Interest Entity operating in the Gambia.

(a) To register with the FROB, PIEs are required to complete the registration form available on our website (<u>www.frob.gm</u>). The PIEs can download and complete the FROB registration forms on our webpage under "*resources*" and return the signed copy to our head office at 3rd Floor, Futurelec Building Complex, Kotu, The Gambia. (b) Under "*resources*" we have also provided a step-by-step "*registration guidelines*" on how to complete the registration process Website navigation steps added as follows.

PIE auditors, in line with section 58(1), must renew their registration with the FROB to continue providing remunerated audit services for PIEs. Non-compliance with the FR Act, 2013 should be rectified, navigation steps added as follows: [www.frob.gm >>Resources >>Registration form for PIE Auditors].
